


CHILD DEVELOPMENT AT STANBOROUGH

The Child Development department at Stanborough studies OCR Cambridge Nationals Level 1/2 at KS4.

Why study Child Development?

Child Development covers all aspects of child development and parental responsibility, from conception to five years. Students develop the essential theoretical knowledge and practical skills needed to create the best conditions for a child's development and well-being.

The course has a mix of practical and theoretical elements and will develop skills and understanding for students to go into an apprenticeship in an Early Years setting or onto a Level 3 qualification.

CURRICULUM KS4

Child Development students will begin the course with an introduction to a wide range of skills that they will need throughout the course.

The course is split into three units:

R018: Health and well-being for child development (exam -50%)

This unit provides an overview of the roles and responsibilities of parenthood, from pre-conception through antenatal to postnatal care. Students develop an appreciation of the importance of creating the best conditions for a child to thrive.

R019: Understand the equipment and nutritional needs of children from birth to five years (internally assessed -25%)

Students learn about the range of equipment and nutritional and hygiene requirements of children from birth to five years, and they demonstrate in a practical activity how these needs are met to promote a child's development and well-being.

R020: Understand the development of a child from birth to five years (internally assessed 25%)

Students investigate the developmental norms of children from birth to five years and develop an understanding of the impact of play on the developmental norms. They apply and demonstrate their knowledge and understanding through practical activities.

Child Development will be taught in computer rooms. Students will be given presentation folders to keep their work.
