


Getting started on Microsoft Teams... a quick 'set up' guide for students




How do Laccess Microsoft Teams?

 Via your email in Microsoft Outlook (you must use your school email account)

Click on this in the top left corner of your email

How do I access Microsoft Teams?

 Or you can add it as an App from the App store on your device, and sign in using your school email log-in details




How will I know if my teacher wants to set up a class and run a live lesson?


- You will get an email to your school email address, telling you that you have been invited to join a Team. You class will be coded similarly to this: 2020 11B/Hi1.
- You will know which teacher has set this up
- Simply click on your App or access via your email page, as shown previously

What will it look like then?

- Click on Teams at the bottom/side and all the Teams you are in will appear like this...
- Click on that




This is what you see next - it's a bit like WhatsApp, where you can all type messages and reply

- Your teacher will set up a live lesson
- You will get an email that invites you to it
- To see if you have any live lessons scheduled, you can click on your calendar



- If you have a lesson, it will appear in your calendar and you can just click on it, and then click on 'join' at the scheduled time
- Lessons should be scheduled at a time when you would normally have it, if you were in school

- Your teacher will upload any resources for you to us
- To use these resources access the files section within the Team
