Dear Year 10 Student,

Year 10 Mock Examinations 17 May 2021 – 28 May 2021

I am writing to inform you of the first set of Mock Examinations for your GCSE studies.

These examinations are an essential part of preparation for the GCSE examinations. They give subject teachers an opportunity to assess your current knowledge and understanding of each subject, as well as how you perform under exam conditions. The results of these assessments will help us to arrange for targeted support and intervention such as Period 6 to address areas in need of development, as well as provide information on foundation and higher tier entries for the final exams in Maths, Languages and Science. It is therefore essential that you are as well prepared as possible for these exams, so that we have an accurate picture of where you are at in your learning. You will, in due course, receive a study guide which will include generic as well as subject specific revision tips.

Normal lessons will take place whenever you are not in an exam.

You will need to arrive to school at the normal time in the morning and go to your form room for a pre-exam briefing.

For the mid-morning (periods 3 and 4), you will drop your bags off in a designated bag room and line up outside the sports hall 10 minutes before the examination commences.

As always, you must arrive in full school uniform and bring the following necessary equipment for each exam in a clear pencil case:

- black pen
- pencil
- ruler
- eraser
- calculator

Water must be stored in clear bottles without labels.

You will not be allowed to sit your exam if you are late (late entry to an examination room is at the discretion of the invigilator). Breaktime and lunchtime arrangements will be as normal. If you are ill during the examination period your parents/guardians need to notify the school in the usual manner.

Please note that mobile phones, iWatches, iPods, MP3/4 players or any other web-enabled electronic device are not allowed in the exam room and will lead to disqualification.

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As soon as you enter the exam hall, you will be under full examination conditions. This means that you must not communicate with any other student, verbally or non-verbally.

Please ensure you have visited the toilets before you enter the exam hall as you will not be allowed to leave the exam hall, except in a real emergency. You must be under supervision by an invigilator at all times.

Finally, may I wish you all the best for your first set of Mock Examinations.
