






YR 7 GRAPHICS







TASTY TREAT TIME!

Custard edition!

INGREDIENTS

METHOD

- 200ml double cream
- 700ml semi skimmed milk
- 4 large egg yolks
- 3 tbsp cornflour
- 100g caster sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract

- Prepare your bowl, pot, pan and whisk and wash hands before starting.
- Put the cream and milk together into a large pan and bring it just below boiling point on a medium heat making sure it does not burn.
- Separate the yolks from the egg whites by bringing them back and forth between the two halves of the eggshells (Save the whites for something you could make later on).
- Meanwhile in a bowl whisk the yolks, cornflour, sugar and vanilla and then pour the hot mixture into the sugar mixture whisking continuously.
- Finally, wipe out the saucepan and pour the mixture back into it.
- Heat gently and stir using a wooden spoon until the custard is thickened before any lumps form.
