RE: Heatwave Monday 18th July and Tuesday 19th July. Early closure at 1pm.

The DfE (Department for Education) has recommended that schools remain open on Monday and Tuesday next week but if necessary have been given the flexibility to consider rearranging school start, finish and break times to avoid teaching during very hot conditions.
