

### Artist shares art tribute in memory of the Queen

Claire Easton had created the image of a postage stamp on Bamburgh Beach for the Platinum of the Jubilee. Eason, from Beadnell, had created the image of a postage stamp on Bamburgh Beach for the Platinum Jubilee. As the sea washed her artwork away, it left all but the crown, which Ms Eason felt was poignant. She said: "The unexpected way the sea claimed it really felt like a goodbye at the time."

"I didn't share it for the Jubilee as it wasn't celebratory."

"However, it felt right to mark The Queen's sudden passing as it was a natural continuation of my own work which seemed to reflect the continuity of her reign, something so many people have focused on."
