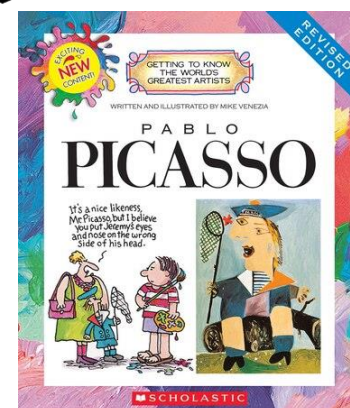
Drawing nature

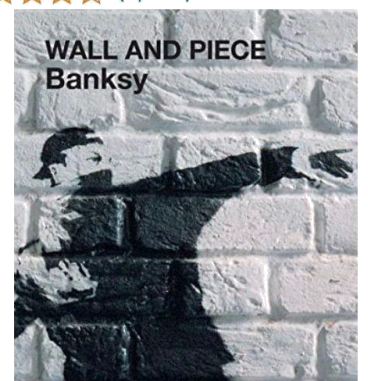

Archaeologists discover Pre-Roman Etruscan Temple in Italy

Archaeologists recently discovered Etruscan temple in the ancient city of Vulci in what is now Italy. Researchers estimated that the temple was constructed in either 5th or 6th century BCE and is roughly the same size as the nearby Tempio Grande, a building excavated in the 1950s.

“This duplication of monumental buildings in an Etruscan city is rare, and indicated an exceptional finding”, the University of Mainz archaeologist Paul P. Pasieka told the University of Freiburg’s communication office.
