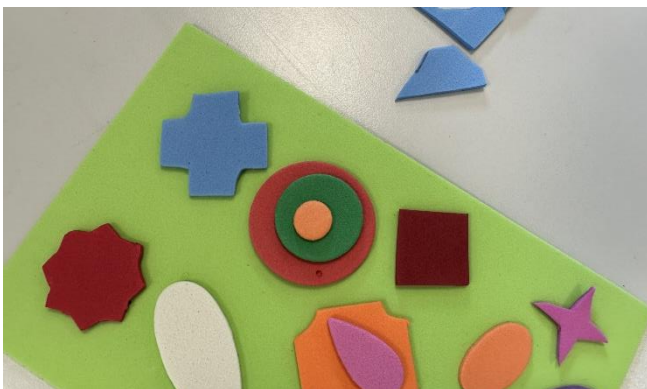
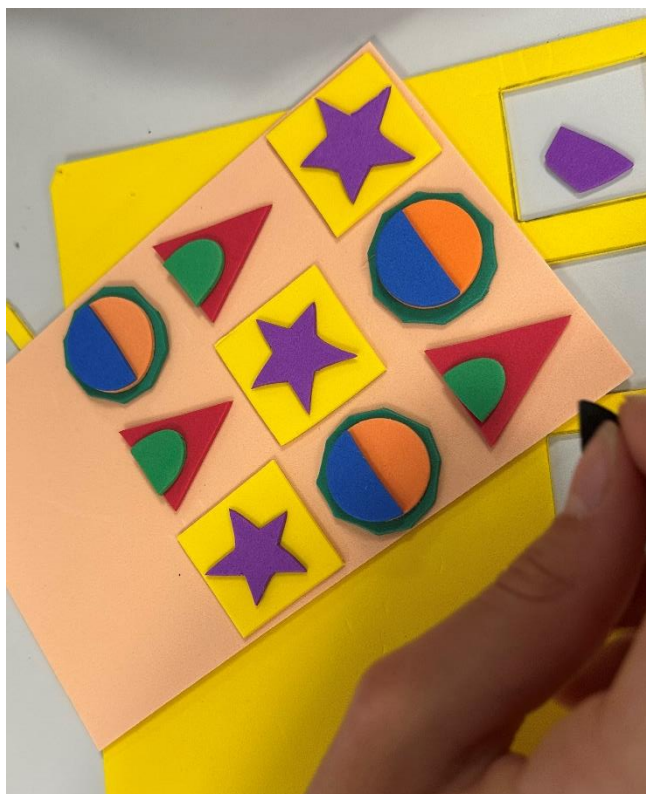
Independent boards

Year 8 have been working with foam felt this week, exploring contrasting patterns and using different materials.





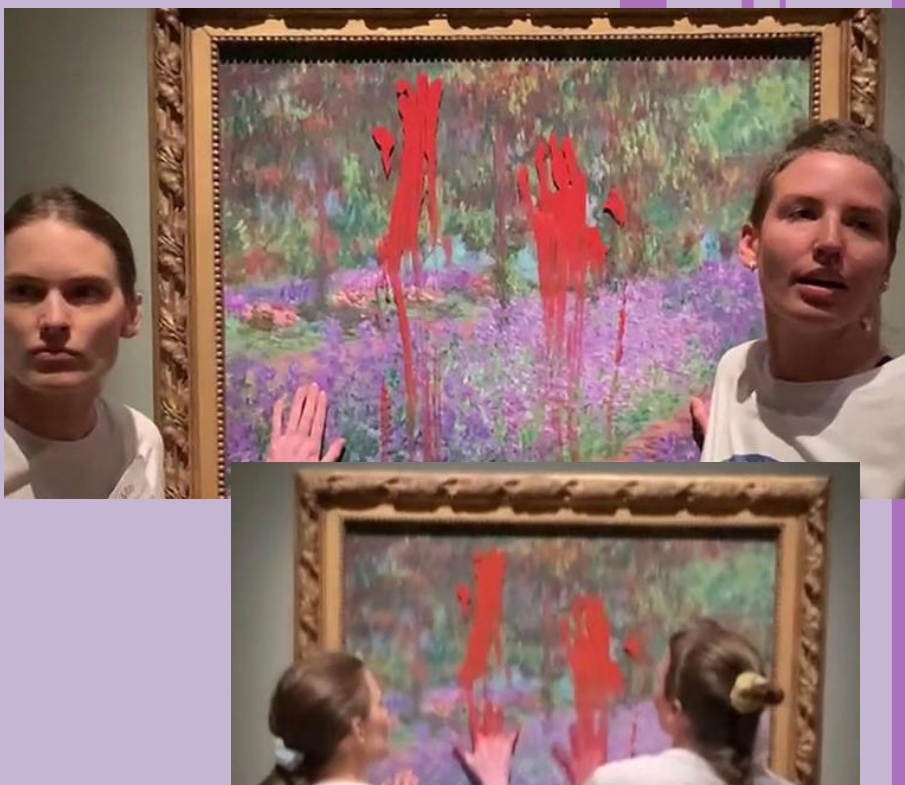
Art in the news

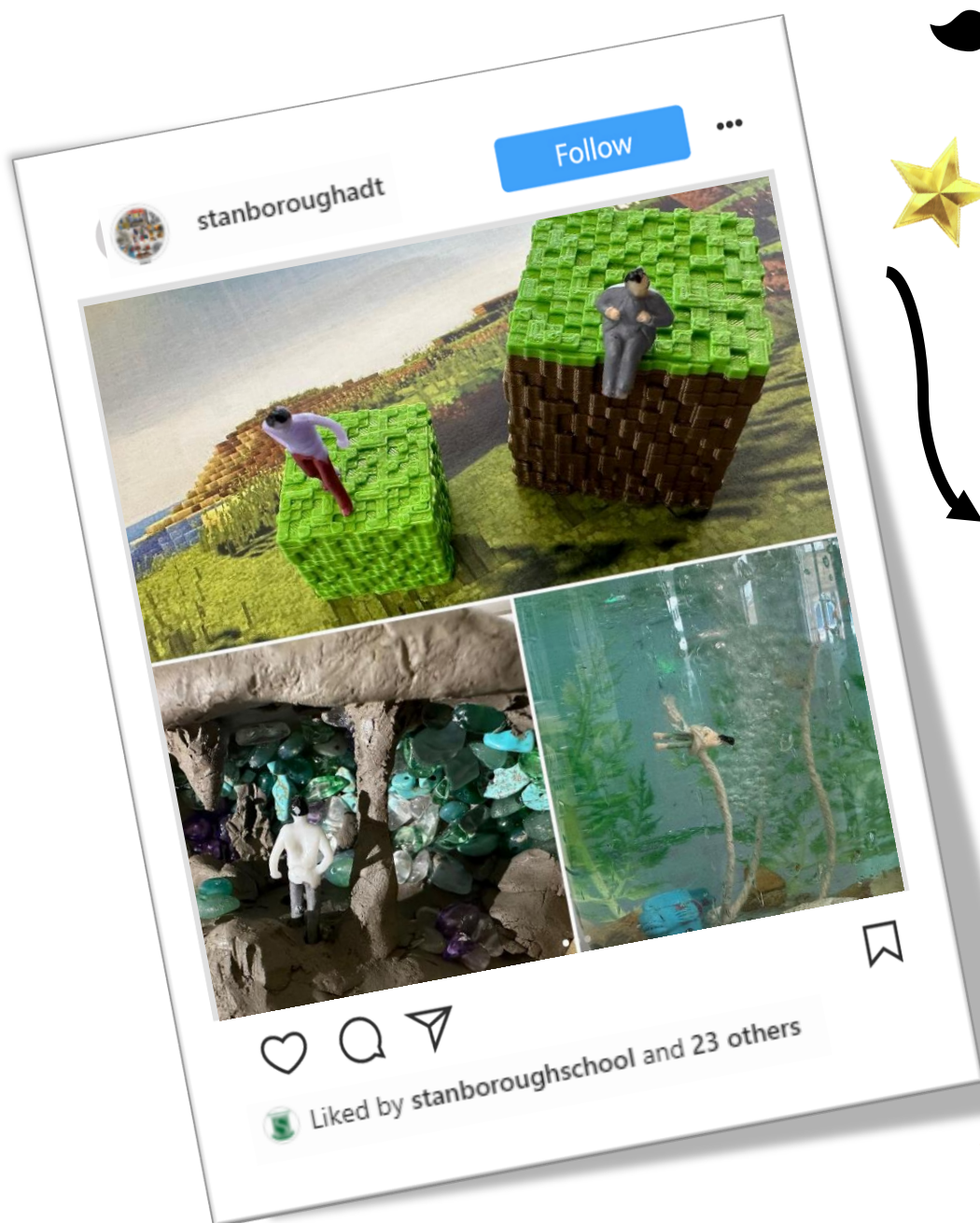

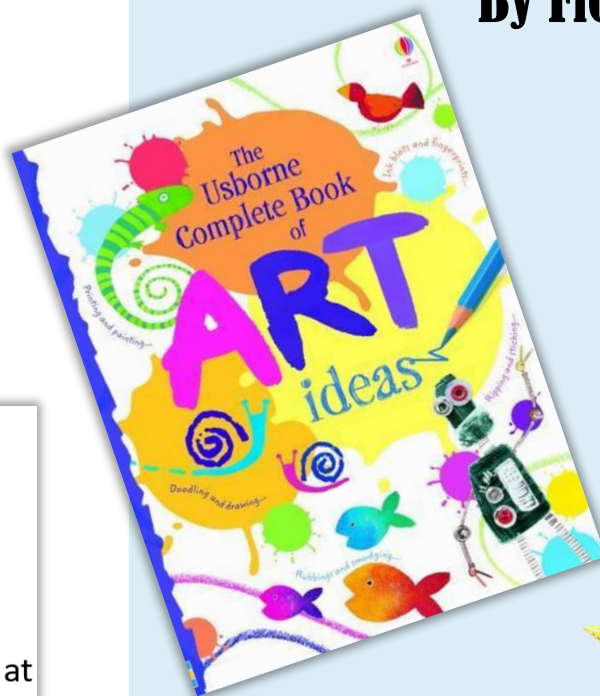

Banksy Stages Rare Exhibition in Glasgow

Street artist Banksy is to open his first exhibition in 14 years in Glasgow – thanks to his part to the city's cheeky take on art.

The solo show, called Cut & Run, is taking place at the city's Gallery of Modern Art and has been officially authorised by the elusive graffiti artist.

It spans 25 years and will feature many of the stencils he has used to create his work. Banksy said: "I've kept these stencils hidden away for years mindful they could be used as evidence in a charge of criminal damage."
