Stanborough School Transition Day and New Intake Evening - 13th July 2023

Back in March we wrote to you to welcome you and your child to our Stanborough Community and share with you the details of the upcoming transition day and evening.

The Year 6 Transition day will take place on Thursday 13th July 2023. The programme for this day is outlined at the end of this letter. Students should wear their current school uniform. Due to the variety of activities taking place on the day, we recommend that students wear trainers. Lunch will be provided free of charge and we have attached the menu for your information. Students are welcome to bring a packed lunch should they prefer this. Your child is also required to bring a pencil case for the day.

The New Intake evening for parents and students will take place at 5pm on the same day. Uniform and PE kit will be available to view and try out sizes at the New Intake evening. It is very important that you are able to attend in the evening so that you may receive important information and start a strong partnership with the school to support your child's education. The term starts in September on Tuesday 5th with the first day being for Years 7 and the Sixth Form only, to support induction and help new students to settle in quickly.
