Blended Learning at Stanborough School (Bring Your Own Device)



What are my options for devices?

- 1. Bring in an existing device (that meets the minimum specification)
- 2. Purchase a device outside of school (that meet the minimum specification)
- Purchase a device through a lease provider (which will include cover for loss or damage and will be broken down into monthly payments)



Key dates:

- 1. Portal 1 has now closed (deadline was 10th July 2023)
- 2. Portal 2 will open during the Autumn Term for new orders
- September 2023, devices ordered through Freedom Tech will be delivered to school
- 4. First weeks in September students will be taught in IT lessons how to access all the websites and portals they will need whilst they are at school particularly Microsoft 365
- 5. Students do not need to bring their devices into school until the launch day, which will be at the end of September. More information will follow about this in September.

- You need to complete the reading journey activities during the summer as these activities will be used in tutor time during the first term



What is Accelerated Reader?

Your Log Book

- Record your 2 hours of reading in your log book
- Ensure your parent/carer signs your reading log before your lesson
- Write your quiz results at the back of your log book
- Your data on the front of your log will be updated each half term
