Hospitality and Catering

Unit 1

The Hospitality and Catering Industry

The purpose of this unit is to develop knowledge and understanding of the hospitality and catering industry in order to propose new hospitality and catering provision to meet specific needs.

Unit 2

Hospitality and Catering in Action

The purpose of the unit is to safely plan, prepare, cook and present nutritional dishes.

Art & Design

Independently developing complex skills in media and techniques whilst exploring a range of artists, craftsmen and designers.

Term 1 Three Dimensional Design

Working towards a design brief and creating a product using a range of different three dimensional materials.

Term 2 Food Technology

Exploration in to the hospitality & catering industry, looking further at the preparation of food and food for different purposes

Term 3 Arts Mark (Cross curricular links, community based projects, national competitions)

Year 9 – 2 lessons a week (1 Lesson of Art/ 1 Lesson of Technology)

Textiles

The experimentation of materials and surfaces including traditional textile techniques and stitching

Ceramics

The manipulation of clay to explore the formal elements through sculptural design

Food Technology

Introduction to food safety and hygiene and the preparation of food with a focus on healthy living

Year 8 Art – 1 lesson a week

Further exploration of the **Formal Elements** through media such as acrylic paint, printmaking and relief. We will study the work of traditional artists and their associated movements such as Picasso and cubism as well as modern and contemporary artists such as Banksy and street art. You will learn how to analyse the art work and how to critique your own and others. We will also explore how art is influential in Maori culture.

Three Dimensional Design

The making of a functional and aesthetic product through practical skills and CAD/CAM programming

Graphics

The application of design elements and illustration to effectively communicate ideas

Photography

The creative application, manipulation and process of recording the world through the lens of a camera

Year 7 Art – 1 lesson a week

An Introduction to the **Formal Elements** of art through media and materials such as printmaking, watercolour and oil pastels. We will study the work of traditional artists such as Kandinsky through to modern and contemporary artists such as Abbie Diamond. You will learn how to talk about the art work and how to annotate your own. We will also explore how art is influential in Islamic culture.
