## Year 7 Art-1 lesson a week

An Introduction to the Formal Elements of art through media and materials such as printmaking, watercolour and oil pastels. We will study the work of traditional artists such as Kandinsky through to modern and contemporary artists such as Abby Diamond. You will learn how to talk about the art work and how to annotate your own. We will also explore how art is influential in Islamic culture.

## Year 8 Art-1 lesson a week

Further exploration of the Formal Elements through media such as acrylic paint, printmaking and relief. We will study the work of traditional artists and their associated movements such as Picasso and cubism as well as modern and contemporary artists such as Banksy and street art. You will learn how to analyse the art work and how to critique your own and others. We will also explore how art is influential in Maori culture.
