Year 11 Parent Information Evening 19.9.2023 and Mock Examinations 16.10.2023 – 3.11.2023

I hope you enjoyed the summer break and your child had a good start to the new academic year. I am writing to you to inform you of the first set of mock examinations for Year 11 and to invite you to our **Year 11 Parent Information Evening on Tuesday 19.9.2023 between 4.30pm and 5.30pm**. During this evening, we will provide key information about the Year 11 learning journey and how to effectively support your child with their GCSE study both at home and school. Please enter the school via the main reception for this evening and the presentation will take place in the main hall. Refreshments will be provided in the canteen.

These mocks are an essential part of preparation for the public GCSE examinations. They give subject teachers an opportunity to assess your child's current knowledge and understanding of each subject, the progress they have made since the Year 10 mocks as well as how they perform under exam conditions. A final set of mock exams has been scheduled for January/February 2024 (29.1.24 – 9.2.2024).

The results of these mocks will help us to arrange for targeted support and intervention to address areas in need of development, as well as provide initial information on foundation and higher tier entries for the final exams in Maths, Languages and Science. It is therefore essential that your child is as well prepared as possible for these exams, so that we have an accurate picture of where they are at in their learning.

In order to support students in the run up to the mocks we are offering a number of additional interventions which we will outline in more detail during the Year 11 Parent Information evening.

A timetable for Mock Examinations is attached below. Students have been issued with a copy of this timetable in form time. Students will be issued an individual timetable nearer the exams, which will provide further information on rooms and Access Arrangements (where applicable).

Students will arrive to school at the normal time in the morning and go to their form room for registration. For the periods 3 and 4 or period 5 examinations, students will drop their bags off first at a designated location and then line up in form and alphabetical order outside the sports hall 10 minutes before the examination commences.

As always, students must arrive in full school uniform and bring the following necessary equipment for each exam in a clear pencil case:

- black pen x2
- pencil, eraser & sharpener
- ruler
- calculator
- Maths set (compass, protractor)
- highlighters (students are permitted to highlight parts of a question, however, answers must not be highlighted)

Water must be stored in clear bottles without labels or writing (i.e. logos). Electronic devices, watches and any other items are not permitted in the exam room.





Students will not be allowed to sit their exam if they are late.

Break time and lunchtime arrangements will be as normal. If your child is ill during the examination period please notify the school in the usual manner.

Finally, may I thank you for your continuing support in ensuring that your child achieves all they are capable of. The results of these exams will be shared with students as soon as they have been marked and moderated by departments.
