Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Year 9 geography trip to Walton-on-the-Naze 26th September

The geography department are delighted to announce the first student trip of the year for Year 9 to Walton-on-the-Naze in Essex. This trip coincides with the Year 9 study of coasts. Students will be looking at the causes and influences of coastal erosion and how this can be managed.

The cost of the trip is £31 and includes coach travel to and from Walton-on-the-Naze. Students will be accompanied by members of staff at all times, departing the school promptly at 0800 and arriving back at the school no later than 1700. You will need to provide a packed lunch and snacks for your child for the trip.

What clothes should my child wear?

Children do not need to wear their school uniform for the trip and can come in their own clothes appropriate for the weather conditions. Students should also bring a waterproof in the event of rain and sensible footwear such as trainers or walking boots. You may also want to pack a spare pair of socks, shorts and a small towel.

The trip is optional but promises to be a fantastic opportunity for students to learn about how their studies in the classroom translate to the real world.

There are 64 places for this trip and in order to secure your child's place, please complete the attached return slip and return to Mrs Macdonald in F10, no later than Thursday 21st September. If student numbers exceed the number of places available, then a ballot will be held. Following the ballot you will be contacted and payment will be required via Arbor. Should there be more than 64 students then your child will be placed on a standby list.
