

Subject and course selection

- Read the website carefully about entrance requirements
- Look carefully at individual subject entrance requirements
- Importance of Maths and English results at **GCSE**



Entry requirements

Standard entry requirement for the Welwyn Hatfield Consortium is five Grade 9-4 GCSEs including English and Maths at Grade 4 or above.

Some subjects will have additional entry requirements and all have a recommended GCSE Average Points Score (APS).



Entry requirements

The APS requirement means that every subject counts.


Offers are made based on teacher predictions. Your mock exams will give me the first indication of your potential – they are important.



Pathways

Four pathways are available.

The pathways are dependent on the student's average points score (APS) at GCSE level.







A worked example

Gives an APS of 6.0

Look carefully at APS as it gives an indication of suitability for a particular programme of study

About T Levels

T Levels are a 2-year qualification that you can do after GCSEs as an alternative to A levels, other post-16 courses or an apprenticeship.


They have been designed with leading businesses and employers to give you the knowledge and skills you need.



GET AHEAD IN YOUR CAREER

You'll spend 80% of your time in the classroom and 20% on a minimum of 45-day placement with an employer to give you the skills and knowledge companies look for. Education and childcare is more.

Your industry placement gives you the chance to learn what a real career is like while you continue your studies.







What T Levels are being offered?

Within the consortium we are offering 2 different T levels:

- **Business Management and Administration**
- **Education and Early Years**

22nd August 2024 – GCSE results day and 6th form enrolment
