




Van Gough Exhibition featuring Pokémon Exhibition

One of the employees is accused of embezzling a box of specially produced Pokémon cards, according to local media reports. At least four members of staff have been let go from the Van Gough Museum in Amsterdam for alleged misconduct during the institutions wildly popular Pokémon exhibition. Security guards and front of house employees allegedly provided potential visitors with insider information on how to get limited tickets to the show, which featured six small paintings featuring Pokémon characters inspired by Van Gough. Another employee allegedly embezzled a box of Pokémon cards that had been produced by the exhibition.



Banksy's Shredded Girl with a Balloon, renamed and redated again

It's the work of art that keeps on giving. Banksy's Girl with Balloon which was renamed Love is in the Bin by the artists studio Pest Control after it was shredded during a live



auction at Sotheby's in 2018, has quietly been renamed and given a new date for the second time. The new piece started in 2021, which is when the old piece was destroyed. So we can assume that Banksy wanted to change the name because the piece is a new painting clarifying with the art newspaper, he notes that any destruction of the work was symbolic. There was physically only one work, but the change in title implies that the work changed status in the mind of the artist.
