Dear Parent / Carer,

We are running a summer school at Stanborough for students joining us in Year 7 in September. The summer school will run from Monday 19th to Friday 23rd August 2024. The aim of the summer school is to support students' well-being and develop their confidence and resilience ahead of joining Stanborough in September. Students will also have the chance to meet some of the staff at Stanborough and familiarise themselves with the layout of the school.

We are inviting all new Year 7 students to take part in the week and places will be offered on a first come first served basis as places are limited.

During the week, students will take part in a range of activities including sport, cooking, team building, art and technology. Students will be put in groups of up to 20 students and will be with these students during the week rotating around the activities.

Key information:

- Summer school runs from Monday 19th to Friday 23rd August from 9am to 3pm each day.
- Students should report to the main school entrance at 9am each day and will be taken through to the hall to register. They will be released from the site manager's entrance at 3pm.
- Students should wear clothes suitable for sport e.g. shorts, t-shirt and trainers and bring a hat and sun tan lotion as some of the activities will take place outside.
- Lunch will not be provided so students will need to bring a packed lunch and snack for break time as well as a water bottle. This can be filled up at school if needed.
- On the final day, we will be holding a ceremony to celebrate the work of the students during the week. We would like to invite all parents to this from 2.30pm.
