With the emphasis on practical materials, we endeavour to broaden the knowledge and understanding of different mediums and materials through a wide range of projects across Art and Technology specialisms. As you may be aware, there is a high level of quantity and cost in buying these resources to support our students which increase year on year. To continue to deliver this successful curriculum and maintain the highest quality and standard of work, we are looking at various ways of funding to support a proportion of the costs.

Amongst a variety of different media and materials, your child will get the opportunity to experiment with clay, oil pastels, print making, sculpture, paint, textiles, wood and other mediums.

In order for us to maintain our supply of resources we ask for a voluntary contribution of £5 per student to cover the materials used over the next 3 years. All outcomes made by the students can be taken away when completed and assessed. This is normal practice in many schools.
