Electric Scooters

Mrs Vlijter, Assistant Headteacher, writes:

Some people have reported students riding their e scooters to school, I expect they must be parking them in the local area. Please note the law on electric scooters on the UK:

Privately Owned E-Scooters: It is illegal to use privately owned e-scooters on public roads, pavements, cycle lanes, or any public spaces. This restriction applies regardless of the rider's age. The only legal use of privately owned e-scooters is on private land with the landowner's permission

Enforcement and Penalties

E-scooters are classified as motor vehicles under the Road Traffic Act 1988. As such, using them without insurance or a valid licence can lead to legal consequences. Since insurance is not available for privately owned e-scooters, their use in public spaces is inherently illegal. Violations can result in the e-scooter being seized and fines


