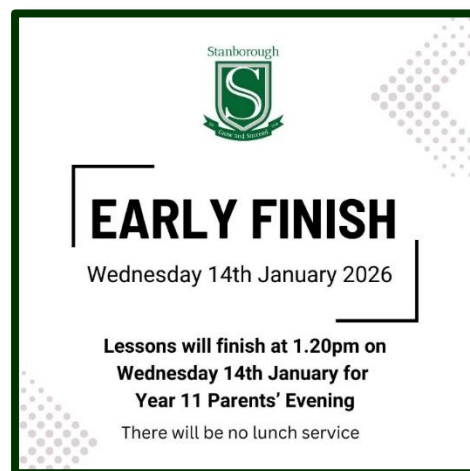
A reminder that school will close for all students at 1.20pm on Wednesday 14th January for the Year 11 parents' evening.

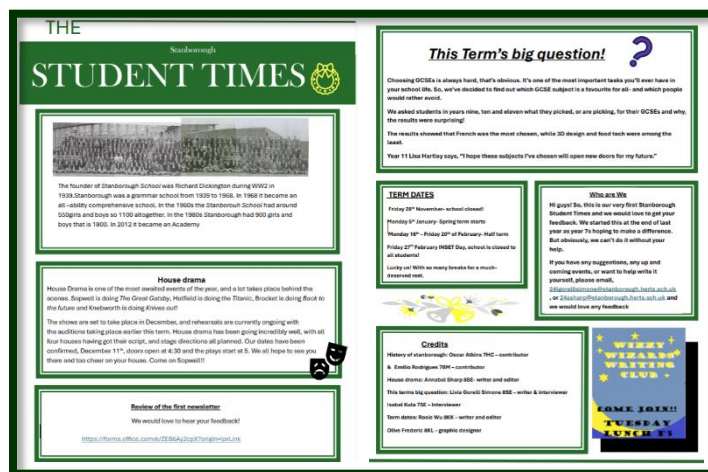
