INSTRUMENTAL/VOCAL LESSONS

At Stanborough, Students can choose to have additional instrumental or vocal lessons, which are taught by our excellent team of visiting music teachers, who work as part of the Hertfordshire Music Service (HMS).

Tuition is currently available on the following instruments:

- Flute, Saxophone, Clarinet
- French Horn, Trombone, Trumpet, Tuba
- Drum Kit
- Acoustic Guitar, Bass Guitar, Electric Guitar, Ukulele
- Voice (Any Style)
- Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass
- Piano, Keyboard

Other instruments may be available with prior notice.



Tuition is possible for both beginners and more experienced students

Approximate fees for each lesson are as follows:

Individual 20 minute lessons	£17.32
Individual 30 minute lessons	£25.98

Tuition takes place during normal school lesson time with students missing part of a different lesson each week wherever possible. Students are expected to catch up on any work missed.

Financial support is available for lessons, including for students who receive free school meals
